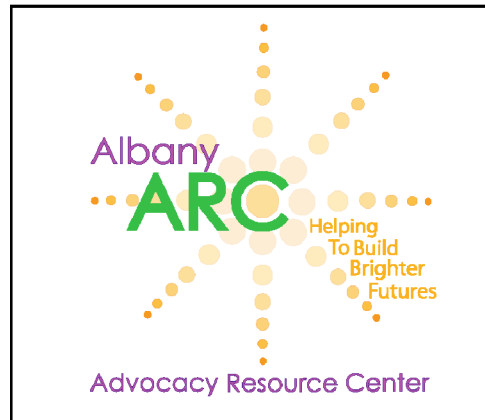


Referrals and Eligibility

ARC Preschool

Albany ARC Preschool is an inclusive educational program that serves typical and atypical children ages 0-4.

This program is designed to provide services to families with children that may be “at risk”.

The children are provided activities that will help them grow mentally, socially, emotionally and physically.

Children with disabilities are included in all classroom activities. The children leave the Albany ARC Preschool more prepared for their next school experience , excited about learning and ready to succeed.



Services Provided

Albany ARC Preschool offers a center-based instructional program.

Two sessions are offered daily, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

Transportation is offered for those students in need.

Each child is assessed and an individualized treatment plan is written for each child that contains specific goals.

The children are monitored daily to record their progress.

By the time the children reach their fourth birthday, they are referred to the public school system or Head Start for services.
